Project and Implementation: The Jaffrey Meetinghouse has what is believed to be the only New Hampshire meetinghouse with a wood roof. The present roof is at the end of its expected life and has experienced leaks. The Town’s architectural consultant has estimated the cost of replacing the roof at \$100,000. Specification and bid documents are now being prepared with the expectation that a firm contract price will be in hand by the end of 2016 or soon thereafter. Work is planned to be undertaken in the spring or the fall of 2017.
