ON FRIDAY the Fourth of July 2003 at Noon, **The Declaration of Independence** will be read by volunteers, each reading a short section from the stage of Jaffrey's historic 1775 Meetinghouse on Route 124 in Jaffrey Center. Local officials, community leaders and Jaffrey citizens, young and old, have been invited to participate.

Following the reading, there will be a **Walking Tour** of the Jaffrey Center village and an **Ice Cream Social** on the lawn of **Melville Academy** (which will be open). The **Little Red Schoolhouse** on the Common will also be open and the restored **Seagrave Fire Engine** will be on-site.
