HUMISTON

1. FRANKLIN G. HUMISTON, M.D., for twenty-six years a popular and successful physician in Jaffrey, was b. in Candor, N. Y., Apr. 10, 1855. He was the eldest of three children of Amos and Philinda B. (Ensworth) Humiston. Amos Humiston was corporal and sergeant, 154th Regt., N. Y. Volunteers, and was killed at the battle of Gettysburg, July 1 or 2, 1863. Mrs. Humiston m. (2) Rev. Asa Barnes of Becket, Mass. In her later years she lived with her son at East Jaffrey; d. in Jaffrey, Nov. 18, 1913, a. 82. Franklin G. Humiston m. Nov. 3, 1886, Carrie R. Tarbell of Groton, Mass., b. Nov. 3, 1860, in Lunenburg, Mass., dau. of Walter and Martha (Adams) Tarbell. Mrs. Humiston is a lineal descendant of Lieut. Tarbell, an officer in a company of Groton Scouts in an Indian hunting expedition to Monadnock in 1707. (See Indians, Vol. I.) Dr. Humiston d. at the Elliott Hospital, Boston, Dec. 30, 1912, a. 57.
