Marson Moving picture Co., 567 Washington St., but I have no preference, and it makes no difference to me what company supplies the outfit. This happens to be the only one I know of.

I have a Powers projecting apparatus of my own, which I will leave at the Harvard Club the day before the show. In addition it will be necessary to hire an asbestos booth, a rheostat, switch, arc lamp, and enough cable to wire the lamp to the nearest source of current, also a screen.

I am very much obliged to you for doing this, as it saves me a great deal of trouble in coming in to Boston from the country.

He said that a semi-portable would cost between \$75 and \$100.
