Boston University's Sargent Center (formerly Sargent Camp) is located on the border of Peterborough and Hancock. The most direct route is to drive north on Route 137, crossing Route 101 at Bond's Corner and continuing for about 5 miles to a crossroads. Turn right onto Sargent Camp Road and proceed a mile or so to the Center. Drive through the complex and around the Campus Meadow to the Southern Lodge.
