Hello,

When Mike Petrovick and I were at the Meetinghouse today at the Contractors' Walk-thru we noticed that the balustrade above the bell level of the Tower has shifted further to the east. See photos below. I'm also attaching some photos from ca. a year ago. The change is evident.

We both felt this should be stabilized in some fashion, tied down or such. At the moment it could pose risks to people below or to the main roof if it were to fall, fully or in part. Mike would prefer that it be stabilized versus removed as it will be more easily replicated during the Tower project.

Access to that level is tricky from within. Perhaps a someone from the DPW could attempt it.

Or a lift or crane could be brought in to access it, or possibly a ladder truck from a fire dept in the region.
