Hello,

Here's an update following a phone conversation with Dennis on 24 July:

Monday 2 August around noon will work for Dennis. That morning the lift will be trucked from Harrisville to Jaffrey. Following using it on the MH, it will be trucked later that day to Don Upton's house on Rt. 124 at the Troy-Jaffrey-Marlborough line.

The cost will not exceed the quote given by Agway, i.e. ca. \$700.

Tyler of Wright Painting can, if we wish, operate the lift. I would recommend this as he knows exactly how it works. But a DPW worker can do it if the Town prefers. If the former, there should be two Town workers available to secure the balustrade. Ideally this can be done with one in the lift and one on the ground setting those in the lift on the side of the balustrade. I would

the lift and one on the roof (getting there via the lift or through the hatch from inside). I would think the securing could be done using simple rope: tying together the 4 sections and securing it to the tower structure.

The Church Fair people will be working at the MH from Sunday afternoon. So there will be people about on Monday when the lift is there. That will mean putting up some cones and tape and keeping people and cars away from the Tower base.

I can be there on Monday but am unable to help in the actual work being somewhat lame at the moment. I will copy Sean Driscoll with this as he may be available. Sean helps me out on MH matters as needed.

I told Dennis I would get back to him tomorrow, Monday 26 July, to confirm the 2 August date and the availability of 2 DPW workers to assist in the operation.

So please get back to me tomorrow.
